Both teams scored fairly evenly in each of the next two quarters, but the Lady 'Cats were never able to lower their deficit they way they needed.

"(We) started out slowly, but we regained our composure and finished strong," Ellis said. "We just came up short."

Varsity newcomer Sierra Wheatley led the Lady 'Cats with 11 points, followed by Breck Faught with 10, Olivas with 6, Tori Browne with 5 and Abil Lindsey with 2.

The team will play again at 1 p.m. Saturday in Petersburg and will be at home again Nov. 27 to face Ropes.
