She also suggested that school-district employees such as Bobby Vaughan who were unable to serve in the full capacity as board members might still be eligible for liaison positions.

Among other agenda items, board members updated plans for their upcoming Half-Court Shot and Yacht Club fundraisers, which they will discuss further during their next worksession later this month.

The local chapter of the nationwide after-school program is now a year old. Their current fund balance is \$20,182.
