Drug suspect pleads to seven years

A local man arrested during a narcotics raid about a year and a half ago was sentenced on Tuesday morning to seven years in prison.


Lucas Jeremy Morin, 33, pleaded guilty in Terry County District Court to possession of between four and 200 grams of a controlled substance.

Attorneys announced during his hearing that court had dismissed charges against codefendant Elisa Martinez, 31.

"My client is taking full responsibility," said Benjamin Webb, Morin's defense attorney.

As the News previously reported, Morin was arrested Aug. 26, 2011 after a search of his property in the 400 block of Tahoka Road by the Terry County Sheriff's Office and state and federal narcotics investigators yielded about 2 ounces of cocaine.

Other codefendants Steven Dale Dorsett, 53, Michael Alaniz Garcia, 37, pleaded a few months ago to probation and prison, respectively. A fourth, 26-year-

old Alfredo G. Miranda, was dismissed of charges following a no-bill grand jury verdict.

Morin will also owe \$399 court costs, a \$25 time payment fee and \$140 restitution for laboratory testing. He could have been sentenced anywhere from two to 20 years for the second-degree felony.
